The academic year at the University of Chile consists of two semesters from March to December. Each semester is eighteen weeks long:

First Semester/Fall: March to July.

Second Semester/Spring: July to December.

Departments and institutes offer participation in regular courses to international students, which Chilean undergraduates attend as well.


The indicated hours on this Transcript of Record correspond to supervised in-class lectures and seminars. Within the number of credits assigned to each course is reflected unsupervised study hours at the library, the laboratory or during fieldwork.

Courses with the same number of in-class hours may display a differing amount of credit, depending on the level of difficulty and work required.
