Information to apply

Documents required to the online form

1. Grades Certificate (English or Spanish). The average must be equal or superior to 5.0 in the Chilean scale of grades. <http://uchile.cl/u126314>.
2. Spanish Certificate (DELE B1) or Level B1 certificate issued by the home University, B2 in the case of students at the School of Medicine (this requirement is not mandatory for Spanish speakers).
3. Passport copy (identification page).
4. Motivation letter, explaining the academic reasons of the application. It must be written in Spanish, 500 words maximum.
5. Learning agreement, signed and stamped by home Institution.

It is recommended to go over the list of previous semesters, since most of the subjects are repeated every year.

Restrictions

Courses in areas such as Medicine and Dentistry have restrictions when it comes to accepting exchange students. Acceptance to this areas is subject to academic evaluation by both faculties and according to courses availability. Postgraduate applicants are analyzed case by case and only if the agreement explicitly mentions postgraduate mobility.

Academic Information

Academic Load

Exchange students are allowed to enroll in 5 courses maximum. This is 12 to 20 hours per week as a full academic load for one semester.

Transcript of Records

Grades obtained during the first semester, are sent between July and August to each partner University by email.

Grades obtained during the second semester, are sent between January and March to each partner University by email.

Credits System

Accommodations
