Mandatory Health Insurance	<p>Before their arrival, students must submit copy of the policy of a health care insurance for the entire duration of their stay as exchange students (from the day of their arrival in Lima until the date of their depart to their country). This insurance must include ambulatory attention and hospitalization through direct credit at private hospitals in Peru.</p>
<p>Visa</p>	<p><b>EU Students</b></p> <p>Until 2015, Universidad de Lima arranged an official visa for EU exchange students. However, regulations have changed as of 2016 and now EU European foreign students enter Peru as tourists and are granted a 90-day visa.</p> <p>Therefore, we suggest that when students arrive in Lima, try to explain the immigration official at the airport that they will study at Universidad de Lima for one semester; students should also show their acceptance letter. Many times, the official stamps a 183-day visa that covers all the exchange period. In this case, no further procedure will be necessary.</p> <p>If the official does not accept their explanation, there are other ways to obtain 3 months of permission and complete the exchange period. The first, shortly before the visa expires, students could travel to a neighbour country and re-enter Peru to be granted 90 days more.</p> <p>Otherwise, more formally, students can start a procedure in order to change their visa status (tourist to student). Students should be aware that this is a time-consuming process since they must submit all the documents required by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Our office will provide them with the official documents, but is mandatory to bring a certification of financial means (letter of support from parent, family member or sponsor; bank statement or bank letter certifying that funds are available, or letter of scholarship award). All the documents must be legalized by a notary public and then translated into Spanish (official translation). The fee is approximately US \$ 40.00.</p> <p>In case students do not travel or do not initiate the change of visa status process, they can stay in Peru but when they leave the country, they will be required to pay US 1.00 per day (as a fine) counted from the 91st. day until the date of their departure.</p> <p>We know these are not satisfactory alternatives, which might cause inconvenience to some students, especially to those who have not planned a short trip, but we are contacting Migration Authorities and doing our best efforts to find an acceptable solution. In the meantime, students should consider the abovementioned options.</p> <p>Remember working is not permitted with a student or tourist status. Tourist visas are no longer renewable. .</p> <p>Related page:  <a href="https://www.migraciones.gob.pe/index.php/cambio-de-calidad-migratoria/">https://www.migraciones.gob.pe/index.php/cambio-de-calidad-migratoria/</a></p> <p><b>Non EU Students</b></p> <p>Universidad de Lima will arrange an official exchange visa for exchange students, through the Peruvian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.</p> <p>In order to start the procedure, students shall submit the following information at least six weeks before their arrival in Lima:</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Scanned copy of the air ticket to Lima;</li> <li>- Scanned copy of their passport;</li> <li>- Address of the student residence/house where the student will live in Lima.</li> </ul> <p>We will notify students when the visa is ready (about one week before their arrival in Lima) so that they can pick it up at the Peruvian Embassy/Consulate in their country. This official visa is granted for three months. About a week before its expiration, we will also arrange the renewal. As the official visa is granted exclusively for academic purposes, the return flight must be scheduled no further than August 29, 2017, for students who will study in 2017-1, and January 16, 2018, for those who will study in 2017-2.</p>
Typical credit load per course	3-4 hours per week (contact hours).
Standard number of semesters for completion of BA	10 semesters (5 years), the students have to complete 209 credits. Students who pursue the Bachelor Degree in Law must complete 257 credits in 6 years.
Credit system	One ULima credit is equivalent to one hour of taught classes a week throughout the semester, or two hours a week of practical classes. The semester has 14 weeks of classes. Courses could have from 2 to 4 credits depending on the level of difficulty. The ULima credit is different from an ECTS credit. Some European partners use this equivalence: 1 ULima credit = 1.5 ECTS.
Grading	The grading system ranges from 0 to 20; any grade under 11 is considered a failed mark. Grades are organized as follows: mid-semester exam (30%), academic performance-homework (30%), and final exam (40%). The academic performance totals the sum of different quizzes such as group works, research projects, exercises, and class participation.
Transcript Issuance	Sent directly to home university, about one week after the end of the examinations week.
Housing	As on-campus accommodation is not available at ULima, students may choose among the <i>Housing Options</i> listing attached. Students may ask for close assistance in case they feel like they need it.
Pick-up airport service	Free pick-up airport service the day of arrival of students. Students must ask for this service at least two weeks before their arrival date.
Spanish course	Three weeks before the start of the semesters, Universidad de Lima offers an intensive (daily) Spanish course for exchange students. We need students to confirm their participation in this course in order to state it in their acceptance letters, and include the dates it will take place.
Academic advising	An academic advisor will assist students during the enrolment process with the selection of courses.  Students are allowed to make changes in their registration (add, change, withdraw) only up to the <b>second week of classes</b> .
