## CHECKLIST FOR INCOMING EXCHANGE STUDENTS



### BEFORE ARRIVING IN NEW ZEALAND

- Application**
  1. Wait for the nomination email from Otago
  2. Apply online – documents needed:
    - your most recent official academic transcript (if this is not in English you will need to provide a translation)
    - your passport – you will need to scan and upload the personal details page
    - Proof of English language proficiency (*if applicable*)
  3. **An automatic message will be sent once you submit ALL documents.**
  4. Post a certified copy of the personal details page of your passport to Otago ([certification guidelines](#))
- Insurance:** Studentsafe-University is Otago's recommended insurance provider – they provide comprehensive travel and health insurance.
  - You automatically opt-in for [Studentsafe Insurance](#) as part of the online application process
- Once you have your Offer of Place you **must** [apply for your Student Visa](#) – this must be granted before you enter New Zealand
- [Apply for Accommodation](#)
- Apply for **Prepare for Otago** if interested (*Semester One only*)
- Apply for the **Otago International Friendship Network (OIFN)**
- Read the [Information for Exchange Students coming to Otago](#) for a wide range of information relating to your incoming exchange to Otago.
- Register for a mandatory Orientation/Enrolment Seminar**
  - Show passport & the NZ student visa

### AFTER ARRIVAL BUT BEFORE CLASSES BEGIN - ORIENTATION

- Attend a mandatory Orientation/Enrolment Seminar**
- Get your Otago student ID**
- Update contact details on eVision**
- Pay your invoice**, if applicable (insurance, accommodation, student services fees)

### AFTER CLASSES BEGIN

- Add/drop courses** – Check key dates
- Attend Exchange Social**
- Help promote your home university during **Exchange Week**
- Sit final exams**

### END OF YOUR EXCHANGE AT OTAGO

- Pay any outstanding fees**
- Your **Otago transcript** will be sent to your home university automatically
