The Kobe University Educational Program on Current Japan is an English-taught course newly established in April 2016. It is open to exchange students at both undergraduate and graduate (Master's) levels. This course focuses on current issues in Japan covering a broad range of disciplines, including social sciences, humanities, and cross-disciplinary areas related to natural sciences as well. Providing opportunities for a broader understanding of Japan from various perspectives, this English-taught program can be combined with students' own special field at each Faculty and Japanese language classes at the Kobe University Center for International Education. Certification will be provided based on credit acquisition.

Academic load Requirements

We do not have full-time load. For your information, more than 124 credits are necessary to complete the undergraduate program at Kobe University (Approx. 30 credits/year). Maximum load per semester depends on faculty, and there is no minimum load for exchange students. However, all international students including exchange students must take at least <u>10 lesson hours per week in order to maintain College Student Visa status.</u>
