## Basic conditions and terms for the fifth round of Primus

Principal Investigator (PI)	A researcher with international experience, no longer than 8 years after completion of the Ph.D. programme
Other members of the team	Academic, scientific, and /or research, technical and other specialised staff Master's degree students, Ph.D. students and postdoc fellows, research assistants
	No later than a year following to the submission of the accepted proposal the team must include a minimum of three Ph.D. or postdoctoral fellows (plus the PI).

The announcement of the third round of the programme	March 1, 2020
Deadline for the registration of applicants who are not employed at CUNI	April 9, 2020
Start of the project	January 1, 2021
Duration of projects	Three years (with a possible extension for a further 2 years)
