University Museum



In its underground vaults, the historical building of Carolinum hides our **University Museum** with its **permanent exhibition** called <u>The History of Charles University</u> (see <u>video from its opening</u>). Visitors can see the founding charter of the university and copies of the university seals and scepters. The exhibition is divided into several parts tracing the university's development - from the Utraquist University and Charles-Ferdinand University up to its present times. Also recollected are notable personae associated with the university, e.g. the biologist and physiologist **Jan Evangelista Purkyně**, the renowned physicist **Albert Einstein** or the Nobel Prize for Chemistry laureate **Jaroslav Heyrovský**.

All accompanying texts for the exhibits are in Czech and English.

The museum is open to the public every day 10-18:00 for a voluntary entrance fee.
